

EMERGENCY FIRST AID AT WORK

This course is for First Aiders working in lower risk environments. The qualification allows a member of staff to be a First Aider within the workplace to fulfil the workplaces legal obligations. This course will give them the underpinning knowledge to be able to identify different life threatening conditions and also the skills to perform lifesaving treatment

Course Content:

- Legislation
- Roles and responsibilities of the first aider
- Assessing an incident
- Managing an unresponsive casualty
- Choking
- Seizures
- Using an AED
- Methods for minimising the risk of infection
- Bleeding & Bandaging
- Shock including Hypovolaemic and Anaphylactic
- Burns & Scalds
- Accident Reporting

Duration: 1 Day / 6 Hours
